In contrast, rural students like those in Dhasa, Gujarat, at The Junoon Academy—our first ever rural establishment, often experience a more flexible, community-oriented lifestyle, allowing deeper immersion in activities like Classical Dance. Recognizing these contrasting realities, Junoon is developing a curriculum specifically designed for the urban student, one that aligns with their lifestyle and learning needs. However, this does not mean that Junoon is not standardized in rural establishments. Our girls in Dhasa go through similar education and transformation processes differently due to the availability of resources. Junoon will be able to function in an advanced manner considering the technology and availability of resources in the urban areas.

But it's important to remember that Classical Dance, too, can be a real and rewarding career. Junoon's levels of learning

Each module integrates Junoon's Seven Pedagogical Pillars and evolves through our Four Levels of Learning:

Absolute Beginner \rightarrow Beginner \rightarrow Intermediate \rightarrow Advanced

In all these levels our shishyas learn advanced movements, traditional knowledge, and polish their foundational skills.

A session for the Urban mind

Every Junoon class spans 90 minutes and is thoughtfully segmented to provide mental focus, physical discipline, and emotional connection:

- 1. Warm-up and Artistic Fitness: The Dancer's body is awakened, aligned, and strengthened.
- 2. Classical Technique: Rooted in Bharatanatyam and Ballet, students refine posture, rhythm, and coordination.
- 3. Theory and Conceptual Understanding: Movement is contextualized through story, symbolism, and demonstration.



4. Reflection: Each class closes with guided self-reflection an essential pause for internalizing learning, fostering humility, and encouraging self-improvement.

The classroom culture

At Junoon, the learning experience extends far beyond the classroom. Every student becomes part of a thriving artistic community that values expression, collaboration, and growth. As they move through the levels, they don't just learn tougher choreography; they pick up the skills they'll need at each stage of their journey. From speaking with confidence to working in teams or managing time, every step in their training is designed to help them become not just better Dancers, but stronger individuals, ready for whatever their future holds.

Foundational courses for the first 4 levels of training:

- Language and Communication: Reading, writing, public speaking, and effective listening.
- Social Studies: History, civics, economics, and cultural awareness.
- Critical Thinking & Problem Solving: Analysing situations, making sound decisions, and finding creative solutions.
- Collaboration & Teamwork: Working effectively with others, leadership, and conflict resolution.
- Time Management & Organization: Setting priorities, meeting deadlines, and balancing responsibilities.
- Adaptability & Agility: Embracing change, resilience, and learning from setbacks
- Presentation skills: Present oneself as a performer with confidence.

Skills at a professional level:

- Entrepreneurial mindset: risk-taking, self-confident
- Financial Literacy: Budgeting, saving, investing, taxes, and understanding credit
- Personal Branding & Networking: Building a professional identity and relationships.
- Decision-making: weighing pros and cons, evaluating risks, and making informed choices.
- Negotiation Skills: Advocating for oneself in personal and professional contexts



• Basic first-aid and personal safety

Multiple Intelligences:

- Mathematical intelligence is keeping track of beats and comprehending the patterns in music and also in the Dance piece being practiced.
- Kinesthetic intelligence is ensuring the use of and coordination between all bones and muscles and their engagement.
- Musical intelligence is the ability to perceive and express music. Ragas, rhythms, and taal
 influence the mood of every individual and every setting they're played in
- Visual-spatial intelligence is the powerful ability to perceive, understand, and then control, but not deceive, factors of a Dance performance.
- Linguistic intelligence is the capability to effectively use the vocabulary of Classical Dance such as hand gestures, postures, and transitions



Chapter 2

Theory of Transformation

At Junoon, transformation is a journey of self-realization, self-acceptance, and purpose. It begins when our students step into the classroom as students and slowly evolve into Dancers, leaders, and changemakers. With dedicated practice and a nurturing environment, our students grow into individuals who embody confidence, creativity, and control over their paths. Transformation here is not just personal growth—it is ownership, empowerment, and the courage to bring one's whole self into the world.

The students are the bosses of themselves: Ownership

Rooted in the guru-shishya parampara, Junoon instils a value system where students learn from their mentors and eventually build their own frameworks of discipline and practice. We encourage each Dancer to take full ownership of their artistic journey from training to self-reflection.

In Tapasya sessions, students undergo deep physical and emotional training where they explore their strengths, weaknesses, and rhythm. Repetition builds awareness, and awareness builds mastery. Once they understand their bodies and movements, they are given the freedom to practice independently.

This freedom is not solitary—it is communal. Our students collaborate, correct one another, and grow together. They don't just practice; they build a peer-led system of support, accountability, and shared ownership. This is what makes our learning space so powerful—it belongs to them.

Guiding each other forward: Leadership

Leadership at Junoon is cultivated through action and responsibility. Our Train-the-Trainer Program allows senior students to design, plan, and lead training sessions—from warm-ups to Classical technique to creative exploration. In our Dhasa campus, our girls take charge of daily routines and inspire others through their discipline and energy.

They lead not just by instruction, but by example. Having once stood in the shoes of trainees, they understand the learning curve intimately. This allows them to teach with empathy and clarity, helping their juniors avoid common mistakes and build confidence early.

Whether as performers, teachers, or entrepreneurs, they are equipped to make confident, informed choices and support themselves and their families with dignity.

Women who once remained on the margins are now stepping forward, joining in yoga sessions, learning basic fitness, and focusing on their well-being. These sessions are designed and led by the trainer girls, proving that true empowerment creates a ripple effect.

At Junoon, empowerment means identity, recognition, and the freedom to grow and to help others grow. Our girls are not just Dancers. They are leaders. They are mentors. They are the future of artistic leadership in rural India.

Each level of learning at Junoon is thoughtfully designed to nurture the Dancer within, step by step. The structure ensures steady progress with minimal pressure, making the process not only effective but also deeply joyful. It is through this balance of rigor and play that students evolve—not just as Dancers, but as confident, expressive, and self-aware individuals.

Level 01 – Absolute beginners

Here, all students build love towards their body and movement. They start enjoying the present and the presence of air.

After one year of absolute beginners training, we see our students at a newer version of themselves.

- Gains a strong sense of body awareness and alignment through regular floor barre, yoga, and mat work.
- Learns to identify and engage specific muscles and postures with intention.
- Moves with increased confidence, balance, and coordination in both Bharatanatyam and Ballet fundamentals.
- Develops expressive abilities using basic mudras, facial expressions, and simple storytelling techniques.
- Becomes familiar with Dance vocabulary, key Classical terms, and rhythm through listening and movement-based exercises.
- Engages in reflective practices like drawing poses and journaling emotions, building emotional connection with movement.
- Cultivates a sense of joy, playfulness, and presence in every session.
- Transforms from a curious beginner into a confident, expressive, and self-aware young artist, ready to move into the next level of training.



Level 02 - Beginners

This is the stage where the student chooses to Dance not just to enjoy but to build discipline in doing so.

This is how they would transform to be after consistent practice and preparation.

- Develops rhythmic memory and a stronger sense of musicality through structured practice and repetition.
- Shows increased discipline and consistency
- Gains technical refinement in both Bharatanatyam and Ballet:
 - o More precise Adavu combinations and rhythm patterns.
 - o Introduction to Port de Bras, Attitude, and basic jumps in Ballet.
- Learns to isolate and control different body parts, forming more intentional and expressive movements.
- Begins to recognize patterns in choreography, rhythm, and stories—building deeper connections between body and narrative.
- Participates in dramatic storytelling, exploring emotions through poems, scenes, and mythbased movement.
- Engages with Dance theory through Junoon Publications learning about Marg, Raga, and Rasa.
- Starts maintaining a personal Dance journal, building reflective habits and tracking emotional and artistic growth.
- Develops an understanding of perseverance, focus, and the emotional discipline needed for longer-term artistic practice.
- Transforms into a dedicated young Dancer who is more expressive, focused, and aware of their place within the wider Dance tradition.



Level 03 - Intermediate

Here the Dancers, and no more students, are identified with the Dance form. Their reflections are deeper, and they start exploring the complex nature of Dance.

This level of transformation is beginning for a professional journey

- Technique evolves into a language of expression, allowing for fluid, intentional movement across styles.
- Demonstrates fluency in foundational vocabulary, with the ability to handle advanced combinations, stamina-driven sequences, and refined isolations.
- Gains enhanced coordination, balance, and spatial awareness, with confidence in holding complex stances and transitions.
- Begins engaging in improvisation, responding to music and concepts with spontaneity and emotional depth.
- Takes on choreographic challenges—creating short sections, interpreting characters, exploring patterns, and working with lyrics.
- Builds intellectual and artistic depth through studies in Sanskrit, Dance theory, and movement philosophy.
- Contributes actively to Junoon Publications, researching and writing with a growing artistic voice.
- Reflective writing becomes more personal and insightful, exploring themes like identity, purpose, and storytelling.
- Develops emotional resilience by addressing comparison, perfectionism, and internal goalsetting.
- Begins to form a clear sense of personal style and intention as a Dancer, asking deeper questions about meaning and message.
- Gains real-world exposure to the Dance ecosystem through:
 - Career prep workshops
 - Discussions on ethics, sustainability, and artistic economics



- o Access to mentorship across disciplines
- Supports and mentors junior Dancers, taking early steps into leadership within the studio ecosystem.
- Transforms into an emerging artist—thoughtful, expressive, technically strong, and increasingly self-directed.

Level 04 – Advanced

The learnings are not just restricted to Dance anymore; the learning spread over the complete journey to becoming a professional Dancer.

- Attains peak technical proficiency in Bharatanatyam and Ballet, with mastery in alignment, stamina, and choreographic execution.
- Performs with precision, emotional expression, and storytelling fluency, weaving together skill and soul on stage.
- Begins to lead original choreographic work, exploring contemporary issues, personal narratives, or reimagined mythologies.
- Engages in interdisciplinary work, collaborating across forms, styles, and artistic mediums.
- Conducts original research—writing essays, interpreting Sanskrit texts, and deepening knowledge of music theory.
- Leads discussions and mentorship sessions, guiding junior Dancers with insight and compassion.

Child Protection Policy At Junoon

At Junoon, the safety, dignity, and well-being of our students, especially minors and young trainers, are of the highest priority. This policy ensures a safe, respectful, and supportive environment for all, guided by principles of transparency, democracy, and accountability.

1. Code of Conduct

- No staff, volunteer, trainer, or parent may directly contact or interact with students (especially minors) outside official Junoon communication channels.
- Parental involvement is encouraged from an information and support perspective only.
 Parents do not participate in, influence, or alter the content, methods, or progression of any child's dance education.
- All communication related to classes, performances, or events must go through the designated Junoon coordination team.

2. Respect & Anti-Bullying

- Bullying, harassment, or any form of discriminatory behavior is strictly prohibited.
- Any reported incident will be addressed promptly through our democratic resolution system, ensuring all voices are heard.

3. Consent & Parental Communication

- For students under 18, parental/guardian consent is required for all participation, travel, media appearances, or activities outside standard classes.
- Parents/guardians will be kept informed of any concerns, incidents, or changes in program structure involving their child.

4. Conflict Resolution System

- All conflicts or grievances will be addressed by Junoon's leadership, ensuring an impartial and fair process.
- Parents/guardians may not directly confront other children, young trainers, or their
 parents in relation to an incident. All discussions must take place through Junoon's official
 conflict resolution channels.



• This ensures a safe and non-threatening environment for all students and trainers.

5. Child & Trainer Protection

- Junoon recognizes that some of our trainers are young adults who have recently graduated from being students.
- They are entitled to the same protection from bullying, harassment, undue parental pressure, or unsafe conduct as minors.
- Any breach against a young trainer will be addressed with the same seriousness and safeguarding process as for students.

6. Media, Documentation & Device Use

- Only authorized Junoon crew members may document, record, or photograph any Junoon activity.
- The use of mobile phones or electronic devices by students, trainers, or visitors is permitted only with explicit Junoon authorization and solely for Junoon-related purposes.
- Unauthorized recording, photography, or distribution of Junoon activities is strictly prohibited.

7. Safeguarding Commitment

- All staff, trainers, and volunteers are required to uphold the principles of safety, respect, and integrity and complete an orientation on Junoon's child and trainer protection guidelines.
- Breaches of this policy will result in disciplinary action, up to termination of association with Junoon.

By adhering to this policy, Junoon reaffirms its commitment to creating an environment where every student and trainer can learn, teach, and grow without fear or harm.
